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Statement of the Chairman of the Board of Directors

Distinguished Members of the Securities Depository Center's General Assembly

On behalf of my colleagues, members of the Board of Directors, and in person, it is a great pleasure to welcome your honorable attendance of the eighth annual ordinary meeting of the Securities Depository Center (SDC)'s General Assembly. It is with pleasure that I present you with the SDC's most important accomplishments and achievements in 2006 stated in the SDC's seventh annual report, which also includes the SDC's main future plans, financial statements and some reports and statistical data.

Ladies and Gentleman:

As you are aware, the SDC's operations include securities' registration, deposit, safekeeping and transfer of ownership. Accordingly, the SDC registered and deposited shares issued by public shareholding companies who joined the SDC's membership during last year. The SDC also executed different corporate actions which included increase of capital as a result of capitalization of reserves and/or accumulated deferred profits, capitalization of debt or private subscriptions to company shareholders or others; in addition to decrease of capital of some public shareholding companies and different mergers.

It is worth noting that the SDC during last year registered (26) new public shareholding companies whose membership was accepted by the SDC, the total number of shares issued by those companies was (419.7) million shares with a nominal value of (JOD 419,653,120).

Thus, the total number of public shareholding companies, members of the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (237) companies and the total number of shares issued by those companies was (5,083,747,514) shares with a total value of (JOD 21,701,422,425.77).

The SDC also made the necessary changes to the securities registered with it in accordance with different corporate actions including company mergers or increase or decrease of capital. During the same year, shares that resulted from increase of capital from private subscriptions executed by (61) public shareholding companies were registered with a total of (749.8) million shares. In addition, the SDC registered the shares that resulted from increase of capital by capitalization of reserves and profits or capitalization of debts executed by (58) public shareholding companies with a total of (332.4) million shares. On the other hand, the number of shares registered at the SDC was decreased by (12.9) million shares as a result of (3) public shareholding companies decreasing their share capital in addition to updating shareholders' registers.

In 2006, the SDC also registered treasury bills and treasury bonds issued by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan where (16) issues were registered with a value of (JOD 80) million and two issues by the Jordanian Water Authority were registered with a value of (JOD 43) million. Accordingly, the total number of bonds registered at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (47) bonds with a value of (JOD 1,788,860,000).

On the other hand, the number of brokers whose membership was accepted at the SDC in 2006 was (21) companies; thus, the total number of operating brokers at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (62) companies; whereas the total number of custodians, members of the SDC, was (10) companies where (3) custodians were accepted as members in 2006.

Thus, the total number of SDC members was (309) from public shareholding companies, brokers and custodians.

During 2006, the SDC continued depositing securities and their owners in its registers where (771,978) shareholders were deposited so that the total number of deposited shareholders reached (1,026,037) shareholders who own (4,954,439,121) shares which represent (97.30%) of the registered securities in (237) registers that include (5,091,918,558) issued shares.

The SDC, during 2006, also executed electronic clearing and settlement transactions for trading contracts executed at the Amman Stock Exchange (ASE) where the ownership of (JOD 4.10) billion shares were transferred through (3.4) million trading contracts with a total value of (JOD 14.2) billion. The SDC also received payments of amounts that were paid by brokers for settlement, which equaled (JOD 2.8) billion, which were later paid to the net to receive brokers through the Real Time Gross Settlement System - Jordan (RTGS-JO) with accuracy, speed and efficiency.

Distinguished Members of the General Assembly:

On the external relations level with all organizations and associations related to capital markets, the SDC enhanced its cooperation relations with these institutions by participating in a number of meetings and conferences held in 2006, which contributed, effectively in exchanging information and expertise in all fields. The SDC participated, as a member of the Association of National Numbering Agencies (ANNA), in the meeting that ANNA held in 2006. The SDC also participated in the venue of the Capital Markets Forum that was held in Muscat and the meeting of the Africa & Middle East Depositories Association (AMEDA), as a member of AMEDA; in addition to participating in the annual conference of the International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) and the meetings of the Federation of Euro Asian Stock Exchanges (FEAS) and the annual meeting of the Union of Arab Capital Markets.

The SDC also signed two dual listing agreements: one with the Abu Dhabi Securities Market and the other with the Dubai Financial Market to fulfill the requests of issuers whose securities are deposited with one of the parties.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Based on the directives of the Hashemite Leadership in directing different sectors and national institutions to progress forward to enhance the culture of investment in the Kingdom and its development in addition to the SDC's awareness of the importance of its role as a leading and effective institution in the Kingdom's capital market, the SDC enhanced the services provided to investors in different fields where 2006 was distinguished by the services that were developed and provided to investors in securities in specific and all those interested in general.





Such services included the Online Account Viewing that enable investors to view their accounts through the SDC's website, the electronic pledge system which was developed to serve banks who are members of the SDC; in addition to updating the SDC's website in order to provide new services and information regarding the capital market in general and the SDC in specific. The SDC's website is unique in that it contains the ownership of members of boards of directors of public shareholding companies and shareholders who own (5%) or more of companies' shares. The website also contains reports and statistical data of interest to investors and researchers which are continuously updated to enhance transparency and to make available information to all related parties and the public.

As for the SDC's strategic plan for the next three years, the SDC seeks to increase cooperation with national institutions and regional and international institutions related to the SDC's operations and responsibilities.

The SDC also seeks to continue providing its services and developing them in all fields for the public interest as a leading national institution in the Kingdom's capital market where a number of branches will be established to guarantee that services provided by the SDC reach the public. Another SDC branch will be established in Amman where work is currently under way to open it; in addition to another branch in Irbid, which will also be a disaster recovery site.

In addition, public investors will be able to electronically complete subscription forms for initial public offerings of public shareholding companies through the SDC's website by using the Electronic Initial Public Offering "e-IPO" System which the SDC will make available to the public during this year.

It is worth noting that the capital market institutions "the Securities Depository Center and the Amman Stock Exchange in cooperation with the Jordan Securities Commission" are working together to establish a national financial center next to the Jordan Securities Commission's building in order for it to become, after its establishment, along with the Jordan Securities Commission's building one complete financial center. The tender for the building's design and contracting works has been awarded and work is currently under way to establish the building.

Distinguished Members of the General Assembly:

In closing, I would like to extend my thanks and gratitude to the SDC's members including public shareholding companies, brokers and custodians for their continuous and productive cooperation with the SDC which has had a positive effect enabling the SDC to conduct its operations in an efficient and effective manner.

I would also like to extend my thanks and gratitude to the Jordan Securities Commission and the Amman Stock Exchange for their continuous cooperation with the SDC and their productive efforts along with the SDC in developing Jordan's capital market. I would also like to express my thanks to you for your concern and constant cooperation to develop this institution to achieve more accomplishments and prosperity.

May God guide us to the prosperity of Jordan and to achieve more accomplishments and develop the services provided by the SDC under the leadership of His Majesty King Abdullah II Ibn Al-Hussein. May God protect him.

SDC Accomplishments and Achievements in 2006

The Securities Law No. (76) of 2002 specified the main responsibilities of the SDC as follows:

- Register, safe keep and transfer ownership of securities.
- Depositing securities.
- Clearing and settlement of securities.

The SDC continued its efforts for development and organization; in addition to executing the responsibilities assigned to it where this year witnessed a number of important accomplishments regarding the SDC's functions and operations. Following is a review of the SDC's achievements and important accomplishments in 2006.

SDC Members:

Since the SDC's membership is compulsory for public shareholding companies, brokers and custodians, the SDC, during last year, registered the shares of (26) new public shareholding companies whose membership was accepted by the SDC. Thus, the total number of public shareholding companies, members of the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (237) companies.

On the other hand, the number of brokers whose membership was accepted by the SDC in 2006 was (21) companies; thus, the total number of operating brokers at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (62) companies; whereas, the total number of custodians members of the SDC, was (10) companies where (3) new custodians were accepted as members in 2006.

Accordingly, the total number of the SDC's General Assembly was (309) members from public shareholding companies to brokers and custodians.

Registration of Securities:

Securities are registered at the SDC pursuant to the Securities Law and the Instructions of Registration, Deposit and Settlement of Securities for the Year 2004.



The SDC registered the shares of (26) new public shareholding companies whose membership was accepted by the SDC. The total number of shares issued by those companies was (419.7) million shares with a nominal value of (JOD 419,653,120). Thus, the total number of public shareholding companies, members of the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (237) companies and the total number of shares issued by those companies was (5,083,747,514) shares with a total value of (JOD 21,701,422,425.77).

In addition, the SDC, in 2006, also registered treasury bills and treasury bonds issued by the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan where (16) issues were registered with a value of (JOD 80) million; in addition to registering two issues by the Water Authority of Jordan with a value of (JOD 43) million.

Accordingly the total number of bonds registered at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (47) bonds with a total value of (JOD 1,788,860,000).

The SDC also executed the necessary changes to the registered securities and updated the shareholders' registers as a result of different corporate actions including company mergers, increase or decrease of capital. In 2006, shares that resulted from private subscriptions executed by (61) public shareholding companies were registered with a total of (749.8) million shares; in addition to the registration of shares as a result of capitalization of reserves and profits or capitalization of debts executed by (58) public shareholding companies with a total of (332.4) million shares. On the other hand, the number of shares registered at the SDC was reduced by (12.9) million shares as a result of (3) public shareholding companies decreasing their capital and (2) public shareholding companies completing merger measures.

Consequently, the number of shares of public shareholding companies registered at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (5,091,918,558) shares.

Client Identification and Account Set-up:

The measures adopted by the SDC since 22/10/2000 require the broker, upon trading in securities for any client whether selling or buying, to identify the client and establish an account for him on the SDC's database as a one-time event, where a unique number is issued for each investor called the "SDC Investor Number".

The importance of this number is due to the fact that the investor is known throughout the SDC's electronic system by this number and it connects the investor's ownership of securities. The SDC can, depending on this number, provide the investor with his securities' ownership balances in all public shareholding companies and can also provide him with statements of account that show his trading activities in all securities during the period specified in the application.

It is worth noting that the investor is identified and his account is established in any of the following methods:

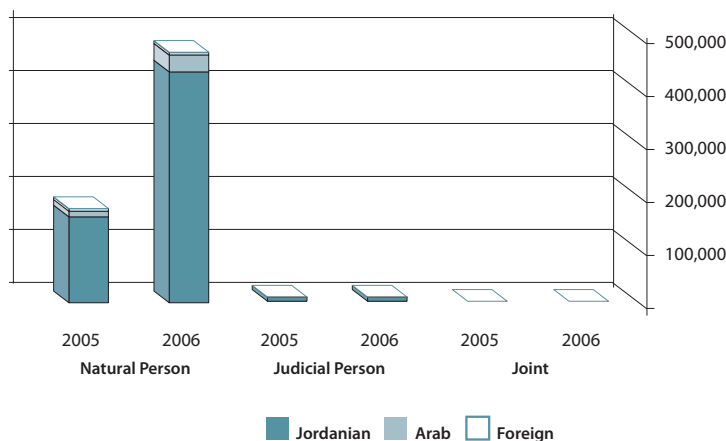
- **First:** Through the broker or custodian. The investor submits an application to the broker or custodian to be identified and his account established on the SDC's database. The application should include the identification document for the natural person or the registration certificate for judicial entities. The application should also include the full address. In this case, the investor is identified and two accounts are established, the first in the central registry and the second on the SDC's database of the broker or custodian through which the account was established.

- **Second:** Directly through the SDC. The investor submits an application to the SDC to be identified and a securities' account established for him. The application should include the documents mentioned above and the full address. In this case, the investor is identified and only one account is established for him in the central registry. The investor has to submit an application to the broker to establish an account with that broker if he wants to trade in securities whether by selling or buying.

In 2006, the SDC executed the identification and account establishment on the SDC's database of (293,408) investors; thus, the total number of identified investors on the SDC's database as of the end of the year was (470,111) investors; whereas, the number of identified investors on the SDC's database as of 31/12/2005 was (176,703) investors. This represents an increase of (62.4%); in addition, (756,573) securities' accounts were established at the SDC in 2006; thus, the total number of accounts at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (924,779) accounts.

Clearing & Settlement:

As of January 2, 2005, the SDC applied clearing and settlement measures for trading contracts executed at ASE on the basis of Delivery versus Payment (DvP) where delivery of sold securities is against payment of funds. DvP is considered an important international standard applied in capital markets.

The process of clearing and settlement became as follows:

Securities Ownership Transfer

Ownership of deposited securities is transferred from the selling client's account with the selling broker to the buying client's account with the buying broker via book-entries in accordance with the daily trading file delivered to the SDC by the ASE where the sold securities are debited from the seller's account and credited to the buyer's account and remain suspended in the buyer's account until the fulfillment of the settlement measures and payment of their value. No transfer or pledge is permitted during that period.

Trading contracts for settlement purposes are either accepted or suspended. A trading contract is suspended if the sold securities registered in the selling client's account maintained by the selling broker are insufficient to execute the sale or the sold securities are subject to any ownership restriction (pledge or lien).

The broker is notified electronically of any suspended trading contract where he must remove the causes of the suspension within the specified timeframe and the SDC withholds the amounts that represent the value of the suspended trading contracts until the broker removes the causes of the suspension; otherwise, the Settlement Guarantee Fund takes the necessary measures to buy the securities in deficit outside the market. The SDC is entitled to take a number of measures against the defaulting broker, which include suspending the broker from trading and imposing a lien on the securities owned by that broker.

The number of trading contracts that were settled by the SDC in 2006 was (3,437,842) where (4.10) billion shares were transferred with a total value of (JOD 14,204.68) million. In 2006, the SDC executed (29) buy-in transactions through the Settlement Guarantee Fund as a result of the failure of selling brokers to remove the causes of the suspension of trading contracts executed by them within (T+1).

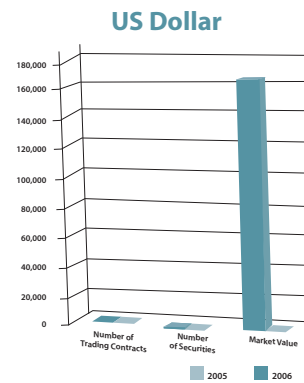
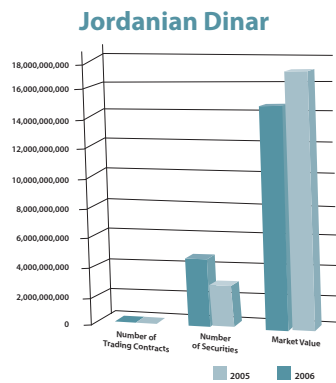

Financial Settlements

Financial settlement of securities trading transactions is executed via the Real Time Gross Settlement System-Jordan (RTGS-JO) at the Central Bank of Jordan.

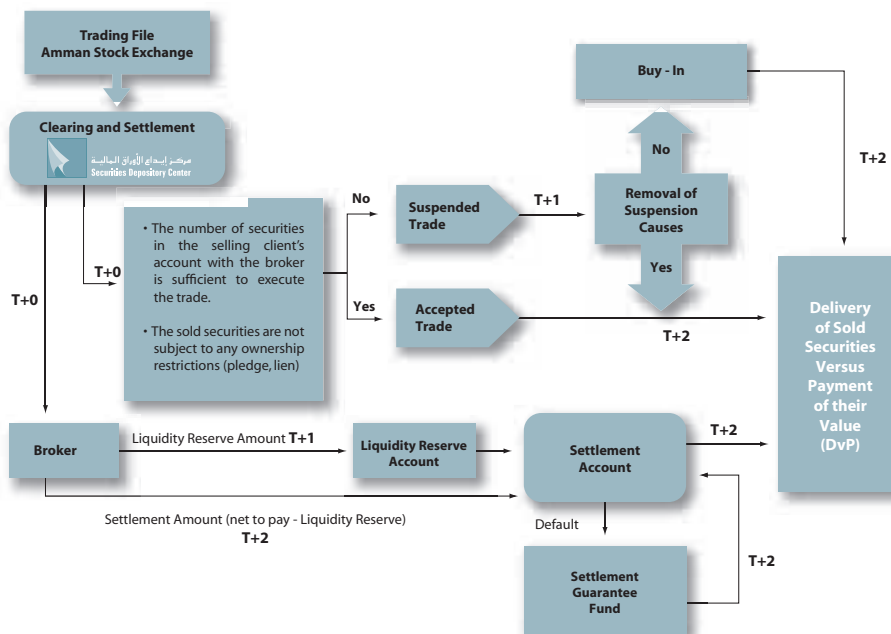
The SDC conducts the clearing process on (T+0) after receiving the electronic trading file from the ASE to determine the amounts that the broker must pay or receive in accordance with all the trading contracts executed by that broker by subtracting the total amount of his securities' purchases from the total amount of his securities' sales for that trading day where the broker must pay the following amounts:

1. The liquidity reserve amount, which represents the difference between the settlement amount and half of the broker's contribution amount in the Settlement Guarantee Fund. The liquidity reserve amount is paid on (T+1) before 9:00 A.M.
2. The settlement amount, which represents the difference between the net to pay and the liquidity reserve amount. The settlement amount is paid on (T+2) before (9:00) A.M.

Financial settlements between brokers are conducted through the SDC by bank transfers from the brokers' bank accounts to the SDC's settlement account at the Central Bank of Jordan (Settlement Bank). Consequently, the SDC transfers these funds to the net to receive brokers' accounts at the banks previously provided to the SDC.

If the broker does not pay the liquidity reserve amount or the settlement amount within the specified timeframes, he is considered in breach of his obligations and the SDC takes the necessary measures to fulfill the financial settlement through the Settlement Guarantee Fund. The SDC may take a number of measures against the defaulting broker, which include suspending the broker from trading.

Settlement Guarantee Fund:

The Settlement Guarantee Fund was established by virtue of Article (90) of the Securities Law No. (76) of 2002. Its objectives include:

1. Covering the cash deficit of a Fund member in connection with his purchases of securities.
2. Covering the deficits in the securities account of a Fund member in connection with his sales of securities in the market.

The Fund has a legal personality with financial autonomy and is managed by the SDC's Board of Directors and the Chief Executive Officer. Its members include brokers and dealers. The Internal By-Law of the Settlement Guarantee Fund became effective as of 31/12/2004 where the Settlement Guarantee Fund is considered the legal and factual successor of the Financial Brokers' Guarantee Fund.

The contributions of the members of the Fund are divided into cash contributions and bank guarantees. The contributions are calculated based on specific formulas and are re-calculated periodically. The total amount of the members' contributions to the Fund as of 31/12/2006 was (JOD 42,916,500.00) of which (JOD 4,684,500.00) as cash contributions and (JOD 38,232,000.00) as bank guarantees.

Inheritance and Family Transfers:

The SDC continued executing inheritance transfers where securities were transferred from the deceased's account to the accounts of his rightful heirs in accordance with the documents and papers accepted by the SDC for this purpose. In 2006, the SDC executed (17,490) transfers where (23,640,628) securities were transferred with a total market value of (JOD 237,471,398.75).

The SDC also executed family transfers that occur between ascendants and descendants and between spouses. The number of executed transfers was (13,839) where (23,213,001) securities were transferred representing a total market value of (JOD 158,518,697.12).

Transfers of Non-Traded Securities and Other Transfers:

The transactions executed during 2006 include the transfers of the ownership of securities suspended from listing or trading and non-listed and non-traded securities at the market, transfers for the purpose of dividing joint ownership of securities, transfers that occur in accordance with the Law of the Government's Acquisition of Monies that Reach Limitation, exempted transfers by virtue of the decisions of the Jordan Securities Commission (JSC)'s Board of Commissioners, transfers in accordance with decisions of courts and execution departments, transfers in accordance with privatization decisions and transfers in accordance with wills in securities.

The number of transfer deeds of non-traded securities and other transfers executed during 2006 was (5,749) deeds where (102,370,785) shares were transferred with a total value of (JOD 439,915,358.95).

Ownership Restrictions:

In 2006, the SDC, as the only authorized entity, placed and released ownership restrictions (pledge, lien or freeze) on deposited securities.

Pledge restrictions were placed directly through the SDC against deposited securities by virtue of an application presented for this purpose. The SDC placed (1,545) pledges against (223,092,193) shares; in addition to (1,542) releases of pledge against (98,286,633) shares.

In addition, the SDC in 2005 became responsible for placing and releasing liens against deposit securities in its registers upon notification by the competent official authorities, while public shareholding companies still remained responsible for placing and releasing liens against non-deposited securities. The SDC executed (3,602) lien restrictions against (37,674,417) shares and (1,709) releases of lien against (23,888,031) shares.

The SDC also provided the service of freezing securities where the shareholder may freeze his securities in the SDC's central registry; thus, preventing any SDC member from transferring these securities or conducting any transaction. The SDC placed (31) freeze restrictions and released (26) freeze restrictions.



Authentication and Ownership Transfer of Securities at the Account Level:

Authentication and transfer of the ownership of securities is conducted at the account level in accordance with the Instructions of Registration, Deposit and Settlement of Securities for the Year 2004 where each investor has a number of securities accounts for the same security. The first account in the central registry and the other accounts are maintained by the brokers that the investor transacts with.

Securities are transferred between different accounts for the same investor in accordance with specific measures where the investor can transfer his securities from the central registry to his account maintained by the broker that he transacts with and vice versa. The broker may not sell any investor owned securities unless he ascertains that the securities to be sold are registered in the investor's account maintained by that broker and that these securities are not subject to any ownership restrictions.

Following is a table that illustrates the transfer of shares between accounts and the number of shares that have been transferred in 2006 in comparison with 2005:

Depositing Securities:

Public shareholding companies continued depositing their unauthenticated and non-deposited shareholders at the SDC by providing the SDC with the relevant documents where the number of deposited shareholders at the SDC as of 31/12/2006 was (771,978) shareholders representing (75.24%) of the total number of shareholders equaling (1,026,037). These deposited shareholders own (4,954,439,121) shares with a percentage of (97.30%) of issued shares and a total value of (JOD 20.6) billion. Whereas, in 31/12/2005 the number of shareholders deposited at the SDC was (291,168) shareholders which represented (52.79%) of the total number of shareholders who owned (3,385,144,304) issued shares as of that date.

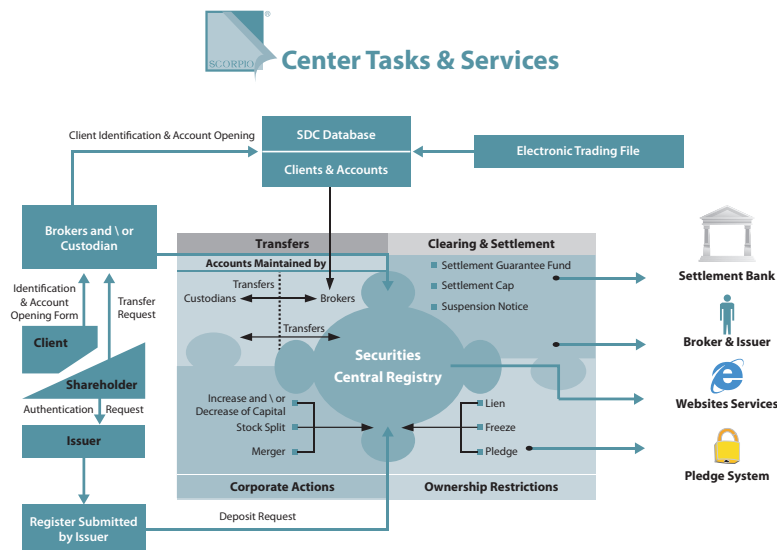

Balance Queries:

The SDC provided investors with services that enabled them to obtain ownership statements that show their balance in securities and the securities distribution in different accounts. The number of issued statements in 2006 was (7,347). The investor could also obtain transaction statements that show the transactions that occurred to his securities where the number of issued statements was (111) during the same year.

Securities Central Operation Registry Processing & Information Online (SCORPIO)®:

Within the framework of the SDC’s continuous efforts to develop its electronic environment represented by its electronic system (Securities Central Operation Registry Processing & Information Online “SCORPIO®”) and using it to serve its members, the SDC made a number of updates and developments to the electronic systems used by its members in order to facilitate the performance of their functions, reduce time and effort where new programs were developed especially for the registration, trading, transfer and ownership transfer of subscription rights. Two systems were also developed one to execute the mechanism for dual listing and the other was specifically developed for members of board of directors of public shareholding companies and large shareholders. In addition, special programs were developed for safety and applying security levels to users of the system.



Electronic Pledge System:

The main purpose of this system is to facilitate the measures for placing or releasing pledges to deposited securities by banks as pledgees. This system provides speed and accuracy in the procedures to fulfill the financial requirements of the clients in providing different types of commercial loans. In addition, the system enables the concerned bank to directly follow-up pledges.

Website:

The SDC updated its website on the internet www.sdc.com.jo in order to provide information and new services to the capital market in general and the SDC in specific. The SDC’s website is unique in publishing the ownership of members of the board of directors of public shareholding companies and shareholders who own more than 5% or more of companies’ shares. In addition the website includes statistical data of interest to investors and researchers. Such information is continuously updated to enhance transparency and to provide updated information for all the related parties and the public.



The SDC, through its website also provided the Online Account Viewing which enables investors to follow-up their investment portfolios and view the balances and statements of deposited securities and all the transactions executed thereto at the investor level at the concerned broker.

It is worth noting that the SDC provides this service free of charge to investors who wish to benefit from it where the investor is granted a username and password to enable him/her to follow-up his/her investments through this service.

Main Servers:

Oracle Systems were updated. These systems operate on the main servers for the central registry database and support servers were transferred to new servers which raised the efficiency of these systems; in addition to developing a main server with two databases to operate the SDC's new website on the internet.

Local and Wide Area Network (LAN & WAN):

Due to the increase in the SDC's members who have access to the SDC's database, the SDC updated and developed its LAN & WAN by implementing new technology to provide the most advanced communication methods for all SDC members and accommodate the increasing number of communication lines. The electronic mailbox system used for the SDC's correspondences with its members was also updated. The number of SDC members linked to the SDC network reached (269) two hundred and sixty nine members distributed in all parts of the Kingdom whereas this number was (224) two hundred and twenty four members last year.

Technical Support for SDC Members:

In 2006, the SDC continued to provide technical support for a large number of its members in the information technology field with regard to connection to the SDC, in addition to updating the SDC's electronic systems and downloading them on the members' computers through the intranet.

Training:

Since the SDC believes in the importance of sustaining efficient human resources, a number of employees participated in training courses and seminars in management, accounting, computer and languages, inside the Kingdom and abroad; in addition to training courses and seminars related to the SDC's operations in particular such as clearing and settlement and the capital market in general.

The SDC also participated in the annual training course of the financial brokers held at the Institute of Banking Studies whether by sending employees to attend the course or presenting lectures to introduce the SDC. In addition, employees attended a number of workshops. The SDC also supported a number of employees to obtain high-level professional certificates in the information technology field (CCSP).

Awareness of the SDC:

The SDC has informed the local and international community of its role in serving investors and the Jordan capital market. A number of lectures for participants in the Jordan capital market were made to make them aware of the SDC and its operations and to inform them of the developments of the SDC's electronic systems and their applications.

In addition, the SDC participated in a number of workshops and seminars regarding the legal and legislative aspects of the operation of the capital market institutions, where the SDC presented the important technical and legal issues related to the SDC's operations.

The SDC also participated in a number of workshops especially the workshop organized by the International Finance Corporation (IFC) which is related to the World Bank in cooperation with the JSC entitled the "Content of Codes and Consultation Mechanism" and the Atos Euronext workshop that was held in Muscat. Lectures were also presented to educate the public, researchers and those interested to make them aware of the SDC, its operations and inform them of the latest developments of its electronic systems and applications.

Cooperation with Arab and International Institutions:

The SDC continued its interaction with the outside community through participating in conferences and annual meetings such the meeting of the Union of Arab Capital Markets and the general assembly meetings of the Association of National Numbering Agencies (ANNA).

The SDC enhanced its cooperation relations with these institutions through participating in a number of meetings and conferences held in 2006, which contributed to the effective exchange of information and expertise in all fields. The SDC participated, as a member of the Association of National Numbering Agencies (ANNA), in the meeting that ANNA held in 2006. The SDC also participated in the venue of the Capital Markets Forum that was held in Muscat and the meeting of the Africa & Middle East Depositories Association (AMEDA), as a member of AMEDA. In addition, the SDC participated in the annual conference of the International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO), the meetings of the Federation of Euro Asian Stock Exchanges (FEAS), the annual meeting of the Union of Arab Capital Markets and the preparatory meeting for the board of directors of the Arab Stock Exchange.

In addition, two agreements were signed between the SDC and the Abu Dhabi Securities Market on the one hand and the Dubai Financial Market on the other hand simultaneously with the signing of two dual listing agreements between the ASE and the two markets in order to fulfill the requests of issuers whose securities are originally deposited with one party and to fulfill the desire of some securities' owners to deposit their securities with the other party with the purpose of trading in their securities in the financial market in which they are deposited and to maintain them with brokers or custodians operating at that market. The SDC prepared the necessary technical infrastructure to enforce the agreements though electronic measures aimed to guarantee accuracy and speedy execution to fulfill the wishes of the owners of securities listed with both parties and to protect their rights and develop the services in the Kingdom's capital market.

In this regard, the SDC visited the Malaysian Securities Commission to learn about its experience in dual listing and a team from the SDC visited the Dubai Financial Market and the Abu Dhabi Securities Market to complete the technical and administrative measures in relation to dual listing.



Future Plan

Electronic Initial Public Offering (e-IPO) System

Within the framework of the SDC's goal to continuously develop the services provided by it through its website, a new mechanism will be introduced which will enable investors to complete public subscription forms using the e-IPO system through the SDC's website within its plan for 2007.

Members' Area on the Intranet

The SDC continuously develops new services for its members using its website on the intranet through the "Members' Area" which provides access to each SDC member using a username and password which will be provided to each member through his e-mail. This service will be completed in 2007.

The advantages of this service are as follows:

- Enables each SDC member to view his information available on the SDC database to make sure of the accuracy, correctness, and completeness of the information and to make updates.
- Enables the SDC member to request necessary changes to be made to the information related to him.
- Enter the required changes in the fields that can be changed.
- Ability to attach the necessary documentation that supports the required changes electronically through the intranet.

Business Continuity & Disaster Recovery Plans

In 2007, the SDC will complete the necessary technical and administrative measures to guarantee the maintenance of information and its fast retrieval in emergency cases in addition to completing the technical update of its disaster recovery site within its plans to prepare the business continuity and disaster recovery plans and the disaster recovery site.

Electronic Document Management System

The SDC will implement an electronic system to manage and maintain documents for the purpose of increasing the storage capacity of official documents, their fast retrieval and work flow between the SDC's departments to increase the efficiency of the SDC and serve its members and investors in Jordanian securities after the adoption of the member's system "Members' Area" in the beginning of 2007.

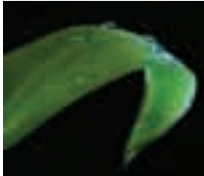

Notes to the financial statements

1. Legal Status and Activities

The Center was established on May 15, 1999 as a legal entity with financial and administrative independence by the provisional securities law No.(23) for the year 1997 which is modified by virtue of the provisional securities law No.(76) for the year 2002.

The Center aims to register, save, and transfer of ownership of securities, deposit the securities, clearing and settlement.

The Center is non profit and aims to support the investors' trust with securities and follow their investments easily, and stop the risks related to settling of dealing process in the market.

The Center's board of directors approved the financial statements in its session held on February 26, 2007.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and the related interpretations originated by the International Financial Reporting Interpretations Committee. The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies applied:

A. Basis of measurement

The financial statements are prepared according to historical cost basis which is modified to other basis as mentioned below for some assets.

B. Cash and cash equivalents

- Cash and cash equivalents comprise current accounts and demand deposits with banks.
- Any bank balance which fluctuates from being positive to overdrawn is included as a component of cash and cash equivalents.

C. Trade receivables

- Trade receivables are stated at invoice amount less any provision for doubtful debts.
- A provision for doubtful debts is taken when there is an indication that the receivables may not be collected.

D. Property and equipment

- Property and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses. Land is not depreciated.
- The Center uses the straight – line method in depreciating its property and equipment over their estimated useful lives at the following annual rates:



Building	5%
Computer hardware	33.33%
Computer software	20%
Vehicles	15%
Office equipment	15-20%
Furniture	15%

- An asset is impaired when its carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount. If indication of such impairment exists, the asset is written down to its recoverable amount.
- The gain or loss arising from the disposal of an item of property and equipment is determined as the difference between the net disposal proceeds, if any, and the carrying amount of the item. This gain or loss is included in the statement of revenues and expenses.
- The costs of day- to- day repair and maintenance for the property and equipment are recognized in the statement of revenues and expenses as incurred.

E. Projects in progress

Amounts paid to construct a property or equipment item are charged first to projects in progress account. When project becomes ready to use, it is transferred to the related property and equipment caption.

F. Accounts payable

Accounts payable are stated at the obligation amounts for received services and goods, whether billed by the suppliers or not.

G. Provisions

Provision is recognized when the Center has a present obligation as a result of past event, in which amount can be reliable estimated.

H. Grants and Aids

Cash grants and aids which relate to property and equipment are presented at fair value in the financial statements as an deferred revenue and this revenue recognized in statement of revenues and expenses based on useful life for them.

I. Revenue recognition

Rendering of services

Revenues from the rendering of services recognized when claim is issued - according to internal article of revenue for the Center - and service is rendered, provided that all of the following conditions have been satisfied:

- It is probable that the economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Center.
- The amount of revenue can be measured reliably.

Interest

Revenue are recognized when all of the following conditions have been satisfied:

- It is probable that the economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Center.
- The amount of revenue can be measured reliably.

The amount of revenue are recognized on the accrual basis.

J. Financial Instruments

- A financial instrument is any contract that gives rise to a financial asset of one entity and a financial liability or equity instrument of another entity.
- The Center's financial instruments principally comprise cash and banks, accounts receivable and payable.
- The above paragraphs present the accounting policies regarding these financial instruments.

17. Lawyer's Letter

According to the Center's lawyer's letter, the total of legal financial cases raised by other parties against the Center and other parties is amounted to JD 1,090,737, and there are one financial case with undetermined amount raised by other parties against the Center and other parties regarding the division of the joint ownership of securities.

18. Financial Instruments

A. Fair value

- Carrying value of financial assets and liabilities are approximately equal to their fair values.
- Notes to the financial statements indicate the fair value of those instruments. In addition, some of the accounting policies in note (2) present methods used in evaluating those instruments.

B. Market risk

Market risk is defined as the risk that the fair value or future cash flows of a financial instrument will fluctuate because of changes in market prices. It comprises the following risks:

- **Currency risk**
 - Currency risk is defined as the risk that the fair value or future cash flows of a financial instrument will fluctuate because of changes in foreign exchange rates.
 - The Center is not subject to currency risk.
- **Interest rate risk**
 - Interest rate risk is defined as the risk that the fair value or future cash flows of a financial instrument will fluctuate because of changes in market interest rates.
 - The financial instruments in the balance sheet are not subject to interest rate risk with the exception of deposits that are subject to interest rates prevailing in the market.



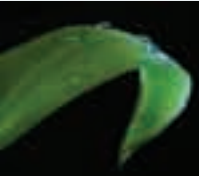
- **Other price risk**
 - Other price risk is defined as the risk that the fair value or future cash flows of a financial instrument will fluctuate because of changes in market prices (other than those arising from interest rate risk or currency risk), whether those changes are caused by factors specific to the individual instrument or its issuer or factors affecting all similar financial instruments traded in the market.
 - The financial instruments in the balance sheet are not subject to other price risk with the exception of investments.
- C. **Credit risk**
 - Credit risk is defined as the risk that one party to a financial instrument will cause a financial loss for the other party by failing to discharge an obligation.
 - The Center maintains cash at financial institutions with suitable credit rating.
- D. **Liquidity risk**
 - Liquidity risk is defined as the risk that an entity will encounter difficulty in meeting obligations associated with financial liabilities.
 - The Center is not subject to liquidity risk.
